**The Sacrament of Reconciliation will shift from Tuesdays to Thursdays at 5:30-6:30 pm beginning July 17th**. Reconciliation will still be available by appointment. Please call the Network office (518-943-3150) to make an appointment. Reconciliation will be available at St. Mary's on the first and third Thursday and at St. Patrick's on the second and fourth Thursday.
